Students who have completed PSY 141 in Fall Semester can take most upper level courses, with instructor permission.

If a student scores a 4 or 5 on the AP Psychology exam, she will be given credit for taking PSY 141 and can take upper level courses.

It is not recommended that first-year students take PSY 205 Research Design. Better choices would be:

- *Fall Semester:* PSY 208 Research Statistics MWF 11:30-12:30 (CRN 93616) [with instructor permission]
- *Spring Semester:* PSY 208 Research Statistics MWF 11:30-12:30 (CRN 23491) [with instructor permission]



Note that students with AP Psychology credit will not be able to register for upper level courses online (the system will not recognize the prerequisite) but must instead take an add/drop form signed by the instructor and advisor to the registrar's office.
