

Graduation Requirements Summary

- Total semester credits required by degree programs
 - Bachelor of Arts: a minimum of 128
 - Bachelor of Science: a minimum of 140
- 2.0 cumulative grade point average
- 2.0 grade point average in the major(s) (and minors(s))
- Short Term activities: 3 (12 short term credits; short term credits are not counted toward the semester credit requirement).
- Two (2) physical education activity courses
- At least one major: all major requirements must be completed.
- General Education:
 - The CORE Curriculum**
 - CORE 101: First-Year Foundations: What's Your Story? (4 credits, only for first-year students, may not be repeated)
 - CORE 102: Conflict & Collaboration (4 credits, Short Term only) Optional for transfer students
 - Inquiry & Communication (4 credits, INQ)
 - Quantitative Literacy (4 credits, QL)
 - World Languages (4-8 credits, WL)
 - Storytelling, Myths, and Narratives (4 credits, SMN)
 - Diversity, Justice, and Power (4 credits, DJP)
 - Thinking Like a Scientist (4 credits, TLAS)
 - Creativity & Innovation (4 credits, C&I)
 - CORE 201: Climate, Communities, and Care (2 credits)
 - CORE 301: Purpose (2 credits)
 - Experiential Learning Requirement (2 activities)
 - Life Skills Toolkits (three 1-credit modules)
- Elective courses selected by students in consultation with their advisors to maximize the benefits of a liberal arts education and to prepare students for life after graduation.
- A student may count no more than 60 credits from a single department code (e.g., ART, BIOL, BUS, CHEM) for the bachelor of arts and bachelor of science. To graduate, a student must complete at least 68 credits outside the major discipline for the bachelor of arts or 80 credits outside the major discipline for the bachelor of science degree.
